- Learning and using new vocabulary linked to different celebrations and cultures.
- Asking questions to find out about different celebrations.
- Talking about events in detail and how we celebrate at different times of the year.
- Engaging in story times and exploring different books and songs.



# Let's Celebrate!

This half term in Reception we are:

## You can help me by:

- Talking about different celebrations that we celebrate at home and why we celebrate.
- Talking about the changes in the seasons and how we prepare for Winter time.
- Continue to practise writing my name, forming the lower-case letters correctly and only using a capital letter at the start of my name.
- Exploring numbers to five all around – counting objects, actions, steps etc to five.
- Practising my letter lottos each week and listening to me read my story book.



## Physical Development

- Continuing to take part in 'Dough Disco' and be introduced to 'Pen Disco' to help develop our fine motor skills.
- Practising moving in a variety of ways during our PE lessons.
- Learning how to form our letters correctly.



## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Continuing to build constructive and respectful relationships with peers and adults.
- Learning to think about the perspectives of others.
- Talking about how to be a safe pedestrian, especially during the dark, winter months.



## Literacy

- Learning to read individual letters and how to say the letter name and sound.
- Hearing initial, middle and end sounds in words.
- Beginning to blend sounds into words, so that we can read simple words.
- Beginning to form lower-case letters correctly, particularly the letters in our names.
- Labelling objects by writing the sounds that we can hear.
- Engaging in guided reading sessions.



## Mathematics

- Learning how to subitise to number five. For example, to recognise numbers of things without counting.
- Representing and comparing numbers one to five and talking about the composition of each number.
- Recognising simple shapes in the environment.
- Using and understanding positional language.
- Exploring one more and one less.
- Talking about day and night time.

## Understanding the World

- Learning about different celebrations including Bonfire Night, Diwali, Hanukkah and Christmas.
- Learning about different countries and cultures including Italy.
- Talking about and exploring the changes in the seasons.
- Learning about past events and talking about Remembrance Day and The Christmas Story.

## Expressive Arts and Design

- Creating firework pictures and Rangoli patterns using a variety of different media and materials.
- Learning Christmas songs and actions and talking about how music makes us feel.
- Acting out The Christmas Story and talking about the different characters.
