Aims:

- To know the way in which 'phonics' is taught at school.
- To know the phase sounds from the 'Fischer Family Trust' document.
- To understand how to segment and blend sounds together to read real and nonsense words.
- •To share examples of the Year One 'Phonics Screening Check' material,



What is phonics?

Children are taught to read by breaking down words into separate sounds or 'phonemes'. They are then taught how to blend these sounds together to read the whole word.

Children have been grouped based on their current knowledge of phonics. We have a 30 minute phonic lesson followed by a 30 minute shared reading lesson every day.

Our workshop will focus on the 30 minute phonic lesson which takes place each day.



Definitions

Grapheme: A letter or a group of letters that represent a sound.

e.g. sh, ai, ow, oo


Phonemes: Tiny units of sound in speech that make up words when they are combined.


e.g. c-a-t

GPC: Grapheme Phoneme Correspondence. Knowing a GPC means being able to match a phoneme to a grapheme and vice versa.


Why are children being screened?

Every Year 1 child in the country will be taking the phonics screening check in the same week. Week beginning 9th June 2025.

The aim of the check is to ensure that all children are able to read by the end of year 2.

This 'midpoint check' will ensure that we have a clear understanding of what the children need to learn in Year 2.

Examples of the 'Phonics Screening Check'.



When?

The Phonic screening takes place week beginning Monday 9th June 2025.

Who with?

Familiar adult so your child feels as confident as possible.

Format of screening

Mixture of 40 real and alien words
In previous years the pass rate has been
32 out of 40 correct.
