

In maths we will tell the time to o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to, and extend this to five minute intervals. We will calculate simple time intervals. We will be reading scales when measuring capacity and temperature.

You can help your child by telling the time using an analogue clock.

In RE we will listen to faith stories and discuss their meaning for believers.



In science, we will study food chains and find out how animals and plants are connected within ecosystems.

You can help your child by including non-fiction texts about food chains in their weekly reading.



Design and Technology

In DT, we will design and make simple hand puppets to help us to retell a story. You can help your child by them encouraging them to embark of their own craft projects at home. History In topic, we will find out about the history of the Olympic Games and learn about some inspiring Olympians and Paralympians. You can help your child by supporting them in using the internet safely to research the Olympics.



During Art lessons, we will investigate artwork with a 'nature and environment' theme and study artists including Andy Goldsworthy. We will use our Forest School area and work in teams to create our own nature-inspired artwork.



In Music, we will sing songs with a 'friendship' theme



In our PE lessons, we will learn gymnastics skills, including balances, core shapes, jumps and rolls. We will develop our running, jumping and throwing skills, ready for Sports Day.

You can help your child by encouraging them to be active at home.



English

During English lessons, we will research and write short reports about modern Olympians. We will recount a real-life experience. We will write an explanation linked to our study of mini-beasts and habitats in Science. We will aim to use the full range of Year 2 punctuation and conjunctions in our writing. You can help your child by encouraging them to practise their writing at home. We are happy to share any super short stories or reports, letters or holiday recounts with the class.



During PSHE and HRE lessons, and during our daily assemblies, we will discuss being safe at school and at home.

You can help your child by talking about how they can be safe at home, e.g. around cleaning products, kitchen equipment and medicines. You could explain when to call 999 and what to say.
