Enrichment Experience

Due to the generosity of the PTFA and the success of previous years, all pupils will be taking part in a 'Young Enterprise Scheme' again this year, which will form part of our final enrichment day before the end of this term. The enterprise scheme will run over a series of days and will aim to introduce pupils to the role that money plays in people's lives and to promote a basic understanding of enterprise. Each class will be given a start-up capital of £35 donated by the PTFA, to get their business up and running. Time will be given to investigate, plan, purchase, make, publicise, market and sell the products that pupils produce. Staff will support pupils to carry out an evaluation of their product and to calculate any profit or loss made. Profits made will be spent on a class reward, decided upon by the pupils and will be enjoyed before the end of this term. I know that pupils and staff will enjoy taking part in the project again and I know that pupils will gain a lot from the experience. Products designed and made by all pupils from Nursery to Year 6 will be available to purchase during our Open Evening on Wednesday 3rd July 6.00pm - 8.00pm.

New Teachers

On Monday 1st July, your child will receive an enveloped letter detailing who their new classteacher will be in September. You will also receive a letter from your child's new Year Leader welcoming you to the year group and providing you with some other relevant information.

Safety in the Sun

This is a reminder that with the warmer weather that we have been experiencing, please ensure sun cream is applied to your child before arriving at school and that they have a sunhat and bottle of water in school. Nursery and Reception pupils are supplied with drinks of water throughout the day and do not need to bring a bottle of water to school.

Lollipops Please be aware that children should be discouraged from bringing lollipops into school to eat at break times and lunch times. This is due to them being dangerous if a child runs around and falls whilst eating one. Parents are asked to support us in this matter.

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My Happy Mind I am delighted to inform you that all pupils at Five Ways have now completed their fourth module from our wellbeing program called, 'My Happy Mind'.

As a reminder, the program combines the latest research, science and technology to help children develop lifelong habits, and learn to thrive. Here at Five Ways, we believe that we should be equipping all children with the knowledge, skills and tools to thrive in the modern world. My Happy Mind is delivered in school by your child's classteacher through a series of interactive lessons and then the children apply these learnings throughout the day.

The next module, 'Engage' has been launched. To further embed this learning, My Happy Mind has developed a set of resources for parents that can be accessed online on your computer, or through an app on your phone. The resources include activities for you and your child to do at home, to complement the in-school lessons. Bag2School

We will be holding our third **Bag2School** event on **Wednesday 3rd July**. Bag2School is an organisation that helps to recycle good quality clothing, shoes and textiles. The items are weighed and taken away for recycling. The school receives a payment based on the weight of the materials collected. This is an ideal opportunity to go through your wardrobes and get rid of any outgrown things. Please see the flyer sent home today with more information.

For this event, we will be again operating a 'Drop off Point' system. On **Tuesday 2nd July** from **3.45pm – 5.00pm**, the PTFA will be offering a 'Drop off Point' for donations that will take place at the main school gate entrance, off Langholm Drive. We would ask that you safely pull into the hatched area in front of the vehicle gate (vehicle gate will be locked) before getting out to unload your bags and leave them with the PTFA volunteers, who will then take them into school. This will save you having to bring donations on the morning of the event. Alternatively, please ensure all donations are brought to school on **Wednesday 3rd July** and placed under the canopy by the main office by **9.00am**. We look forward to your support with this excellent recycling initiative.

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Transition Arrangements

As you are aware, we value the need to ensure pupils are given the opportunity to become familiar with their new classteacher and classroom in preparation for September. Therefore, our transition arrangements this year are as follows:

- Thursday 11th July 1.30pm 3.30pm Children will spend the afternoon with their new class, in their new classroom and with their teacher. *Parents are asked to collect children from their new classrooms at the end of the afternoon and you are invited to go back into school to meet your child's classteacher.*

I would like to reassure you that all members of the teaching team will be doing their utmost to ensure this transition is a smooth one. 'Welcome' letters and information regarding your child's new classteacher for September will be sent home on Monday 1st July from your child's new Year Leader. The letter will contain a map so that you are able to locate your child's new classroom. Being informed about your child's new classteacher and the location of their new classroom, ahead of our Open Evening, will provide you and your child with the valuable opportunity of visiting your child's new classroom and teacher during our Open Evening on 3rd July. We hope that you will agree that this provides another important transition occasion for you and your child to take advantage of. In addition to the information already stated, the 'Welcome' letter will also state the door that your child will be dismissed from at the end of each day and after their afternoon transition visit on Thursday 11th July.

Please do not hesitate to speak to your child's current classteacher if you have any concerns or questions regarding these arrangements.

Parents of pupils due to commence Nursery or due to move to Reception, have already received separate transition information.
