Parents' Evening As you may be aware, parent consultations / Parents' Evening for all classes from Nursery to Year 6 will take place during the week beginning 27th January. Appointments are now available to be booked online. This system has been updated this year, so may look a little different when you go on to make your appointment. You should have been sent a link to your mobile phone or email address, which will take you to the online booking system to select a time convenient for you. Please follow these simple steps to book your appointment:

- 1. Click the link that you receive through text and/or email to take you to the confirmation page. You will need internet access to do this.
- 2. Enter your child's first name to continue. If you have more than one child, any of their first names will work.
- 3. Next, you will be taken to the booking page; this will show your children along the top of the page.
- 4. Please click on the suitable available date.
- 5. Please click 'Book' then 'Make Booking'. When the button has turned green you know your booking has been made.
- 6. At any time before Parents' Evening, you can click the link on your phone or email again to check your booking time.
- 7. You can cancel, print, or email this booking from this page.

The online booking service is available from now until **Thursday** 23rd January at 4.00pm. Please be aware that if you do not have internet access, it is still possible to make an appointment through the school office. (Parents of pupils in Mrs Robinson's Year 4 class are asked to refer to the letter sent home on 15th January regarding booking appointments.)
