Children's Mental Health Week

Each year, there is a week dedicated to Children's Mental Health and this is taking place next week. The theme of the week changes each year. This year's theme is 'Know Yourself, Grow Yourself'. The theme was chosen to help young people to learn more about themselves and what makes them the person they are.

All of us, whether children or adults, are different. We have our own qualities, talents, thoughts, opinions and personalities. This is what makes our world a wonderful and diverse place.

By developing children's self-awareness, we can help them to identify and understand how they feel in different situations. This can help them to build resilience and confidence.

Throughout next week, staff will be talking to children about being kind and respectful to one another and discussing that fact that we all have different interests, hopes, dreams, likes, dislikes, challenges and talents. Children will also be encouraged to enter into discussions about what makes them feel happy, sad, excited or worried and how they behave when they are feeling these emotions. Children will learn that there is no one else who is exactly the same as them because each of them are unique in their special way and that these differences should be celebrated. Throughout next week, children will be encouraged to take the time to think about the skills they have, the qualities they have and the talents they have.



Maths Enrichment Day including Sponsored Active Maths

This is a reminder that all year groups will be taking part in a maths day next Friday 7th February, where the focus for learning for the whole day will be on active engagement and enjoyment of maths. Our pupils will also be carrying out their sponsored event next week which will have an active maths focus.
